3. Authorization letter to the representative of company who purchase the tender.
4. Tenderers shall provide a preliminary deposit (bid bond) of one percent (1 %) of the offered price It shall be in the form of guarantee or cheque issued by a Bank in Iraq in separate sealed envelope with Request No and name of company on it.
5. Bidder shall be either a manufacturer or one of its legally certified.
6. The bidder who will be awarded this tender shall bear the advertisement cost which should be paid by the contractor before signature of the contract.

THE BASRAH WATER SUPPLY IMPROVEMENT PROJECT PACKAGE 3: CONSTRUCTION OF PROPOSED AL HARTHA WATER TREATMENT PLANT

The Ministry of Municipalities and Public Works, the Republic of Iraq invites applicants from construction companies who wish to be prequalified to tender for "The Basrah Water Supply Improvement Project, Package 3: Construction of Proposed A1 Hartha Water Treatment Plant". The Project will be implemented under the Loan Agreement No. IQ-P9 dated June 11, 2008 between the Government of the Republic of Iraq and Japan International Cooperation Agency (JICA).

The project consists of a raw water intake facility, a receiving well (distribution chamber), flocculation sedimentation basins, settled water storage tanks, clear water reservoirs and transmission pump station, a drainage tank and electrical works with emergency power generation.

The raw water is brackish surface water pumped from the Shat Al Arab River. The treatment plant shall have a design capacity of 360,000 m3/d and is expected to produce clear water suitable as feed water for a Ultrafiltration/Reverse Osmosis System.

The applicants are required:

- (1) To be a general civil contractor or a management contractor.
- (2) To be in sound financial condition for the last three (3) consecutive years judged by business experience record. The applicants that filed a petition under the corporate reorganization act and are pending in decision will be disqualified.
- (3) To have a minimum average annual construction turnover of One Hundred Twenty (120) million US\$ calculated as total certified payments received for contracts in progress or completed, within the last three (3) years.
- (4) To have done at least two (2) contracts within the last twenty (20) years, that have been successfully and substantially completed and that are similar to the proposed Works.
- (5) To have a minimum construction experience, as prime contractor, management contractor or subcontractor in the following key activities:
 - a. Construction, testing and commissioning of at least two River Water Intake Facilities each rated for at least 100,000 m3/d.
 - b. Construction, testing and commissioning of at least two Water Treatment Plants complete with power supply, emergency power supply controls and SCADA each rated for at least 100,000 m3/d
 - c. Construction, testing and commissioning of at least two Settled Water/Clear Water Reservoirs each with a capacity of 15,000 m3.
 - d. Construction, testing and commissioning of at least two Clear Water Pumping Stations each rated for at least 100,000 m3/d.

Note: For "b" above, the Applicant should show that the works included preparation, management

and implementation of training programs in safety, operation and maintenance, warehouse management and administration for water treatment plants.
